## BOYS BASKETBALL!

On February 2<sup>nd</sup> the Crusader's Varsity took on RCA and walked off with a 26-18 win. Gage Geist once again led the team with 10 points. Joel Henry, Zach Ferenz, and Harry Meyer added 4 points each to the attack. The JV team took on RCA's JV team and imposed their will with a 30-9 victory. Zane Warkentin led the team with 12 and Joe Gallo followed up with 6 points.

On the 6<sup>th</sup> the JV team took on the Excel Warriors Varsity team and fell 12-31. Joe Gallo led the team with 4 points.

On the 9<sup>th</sup> the Crusader's Varsity had a rematch against the Capital Christian Pride. The Pride took an early 12 point lead and then the Crusaders had their work cut out for them. The Crusaders brought the game back 36-38 with under a minute to go and ended up losing 37-40. One of the highlights was Jacob Kinkel who was 5 of 6 from the line with a total of 9 points.

Saturday the 11th saw the Crusaders take on their 3rd opponent in 3 days. The victim was RCA. This time we came out on top with a 26-20 victory. Gage again led the scoring with 12 and Jacob Kinkel contributed another 6.
