

Bethlehem Lutheran School Modified School Uniform Information

- Uniforms/clothing must be purchased accordingly to gender.
- Uniforms/clothing may be purchased through Campus Club or elsewhere provided they are the same color, and style as the items listed and shown.
- All clothing articles must be clean, unstained and in good repair.
- **Chapel Attire** will be a collared shirt with Dockers for boys and skirts/jumpers for girls. **There will be no tee-shirts, shorts, skorts, or denim clothing items permitted.**
- Available color options for shirts and blouses include: Maroon, White, Gray, Pink, Red, Purple, Blue, and Green. (No neon variations)
- Skirts/skorts, jumpers, pants, shorts, slacks and denim jeans must be solid one color and not faded or in disrepair. Skirts and jumper lengths are to be no shorter than one inch above the knee. Please allow for student growth when hemming skirts or jumpers. **Colors blue/black/khaki**
- **Shorts** are not to be of denim material. Cotton only!
- **No Cargo** type clothing (pants with large pockets)
- Shirts for boys and girls must be neatly tucked in at all times while on campus or school sponsored activities.
- Oversized shirts, blouses, skirts/skorts, jumpers, pants, shorts, slacks and denim jeans are not allowed. All clothing must be clean, not tattered, torn, frayed or baggy.
- Logos other than BLCS logos are not allowed.
- **Hairstyles and Cosmetics:** Hair must be neatly combed. No changing of hair color. No unusual or distracting hair styles. Hair must be neat, trimmed, and combed. Boy's hair is not to exceed collar. In the front hair should no longer than the eye brows. No hairstyles that call undue attention to the student. Only girls in the 7th and 8th grade may use cosmetics, (lipstick, eye shadow, mascara, etc.) if worn modestly and discreetly.
- **Jewelry:** No more than two earrings per ear. No dangling earrings and no loops larger than a dime. No facial or body piercing jewelry. Boys may not wear earrings.
- No visible tattoos, body art, markings, or defacements.
- **Polo Shirts:** Must be long or short sleeve, in any solid color mentioned above. Oversized or logos other than BLCS are not allowed.
- **Turtlenecks:** Must be long or short sleeve, in any solid color mentioned above. Oversized or logos other than BLCS are not allowed.
- **Oxford Shirts:** Must be long or short sleeve, in any solid color mentioned above with a collar. Oversized or logos other than BLCS are not allowed.

- **BLCS Crewneck Shirts:** Only crew neck shirts sold by Bethlehem Lutheran School and Bethlehem Lutheran Sports or club programs are acceptable.
- **Sweatshirts:** All sweat shirts must be worn over proper collared shirts. Solid colors only. Sweatshirts may be zippered or pullover, with or without hoods. Oversized or logos other than BLCS logo are not acceptable. Sweatshirts are not to be worn in the classroom.
- **Sweaters:** V-neck, crew neck and cardigans in solid colors only. Oversized or logo other than BLCS logos are not acceptable. Must be worn over proper collared shirts.
- **Jackets:** Light jackets or windbreakers are to be plain, solid colors. Oversized or logos other than BLCS logo are not acceptable.
- Sweatshirt/Sweaters/Jackets **colors** are Maroon, Gray and Navy.
- **Heavy Jackets:** As long as they are appropriate and reflect the values of Bethlehem Lutheran School.
- **Socks, Tights, and Leggings: Must be solid colored.** Must be worn at all times. Tights, nylons, or leggings may be worn, especially on cold days. Leggings must be **ankle to waist** and may be worn under dresses and skirts only.
- **Belts:** Belts are optional, so long as shirt stays tucked in and pants stay up. Belts must be solid black or brown and made of vinyl, leather, or canvas.
- **Shoes:** Plain tennis or oxford type must be worn. All shoes must have closed toes and heels. No sandals, sling backs, crocs, heavy work boot, clogs or hiking boots. Snow Boots may be worn to school during snowy days.
- **Head Coverings:** No hat or head coverings are to be worn in the classroom. Baseball caps can be worn at recess and are to be worn properly.
- **Sports Team Practice:** Clothing can be purchased and ordered through the school office.
- If it's not on this sheet, it's not allowed

Free Dress Days: As a reward the Principal may declare a Free Dress Day. On those days, students are expected to exercise good judgment in the choice of their apparel. Length requirements must be respected. Spaghetti straps are not allowed. Nothing too tight or revealing will be permitted. Students who do not use good judgment will have the privilege revoked.

- **Consequences: Parents will be called to bring new clothes or the student will wear school provided clothes. Not following rules is a choice and a matter of the heart.**

The preceding dress code is for all students attending Bethlehem Lutheran School and is in effect from the time the student arrives on campus until the student leaves campus. The dress code is also in effect when students attend school sponsored activities. Parents and students will be notified in advance when there are any exceptions to the dress code. ***The School Board designed this dress code recognizing that there is a difference between boys and girls clothing. We are trying to teach modesty, respect, and taste.***

The purpose for our dress code is to make daily preparation for school easier on parents and children and to assist students in developing attitudes of respect for self and consideration for others. As each student demonstrates concern for his/her appearance, the entire student body will be benefited, and the testimony of the school will be a positive one in the community. ***The student's dress is a direct reflection on the student, his family, and Bethlehem Lutheran School.***

Dress Code decisions are made solely by the school faculty and administration and are not subject to appeal.
