This past Friday the Cross country team competed in the championships. Our 7th grade team, consisting of 5th-7th graders, had their best season yet. The team had trained hard and put in almost 100 training miles during the season. The course was 2.13 miles with 14 teams competing.

The 7th grade girls finished in 7th place. Makaela Bigley finished 6th (16:24), Clare Davison 13th (17:07), Emily McNeely 51st (19:49), Taylor Davison 53rd (19:52), and Hannah Presley 99th (24:49).

The 7th grade boys' team placed 8th out of 14 teams. Harry Meyer finished 13th (15:33), Tobin McRae 47th (17:14), Ricky McNeely 48th (17:16), Brandon Hall 66th (18:22), and Alex Bernhard 79th (19:30).
