ARRIVAL AT SCHOOL

Students are not allowed at school prior to 8:00 am unless they attend daycare or are supervised by their parent.

All persons visiting Bethlehem Lutheran School must check in with the school office first to receive a visitor's pass. It is important to keep classroom interruptions to a minimum.

PARKING LOT SAFETY

When dropping off and picking up your child(ren), please adhere to the following:

- **Enter on the south** of the property and travel **north** toward the wooden fence. When parking pull to the front parking space. When leaving back up **OR** pull through and travel **north to the exit**.
- **No parking** in the **fire lane** or area closest to the **school building**.
- Please stop at the **stop sign**.
- Please drive **slowly**, 5 MPH

We have students crossing the parking lot each morning and afternoon. Their safety is important to us!

STUDENT SIGN IN AND OUT

If a student is late arriving to school (more than 5 minutes) their parents must come in the school office and sign them in.

When a student is picked up early or arrives late (doctor, dentist etc.) they must be signed in and out by the parent at the school office. It is important that we have the parents, **not the student**, signing in and out. This way we know at all times how many students we have in attendance.
