Bethlehem #1 took on Redeemer Redwood City #2 and walked off with a 54-35 win. This win placed them on the winner's side of the bracket. In their second game they took on Redeemer #1 and had a battle from beginning to end. They came up short with a final score of 43-46. In game 3 they battled St. John's Bakersfield. They let the Saints get out to an early lead and had to overcome a 4-12 deficit. In the end the Crusaders prevailed 58-41.
