This past weekend, Bethlehem Lutheran School sent four athletes to compete in the National Lutheran Schools Cross Country Championships held at Concordia University in Mequon, Wisconsin. All four ran season-best times on the two-mile course. The top finisher for the Crusaders was eighth grader Aaron Waite, who exceeded expectations by running 12:50 for 66th of over 200 finishers in the boys' race. Seventh grader Nathan Highley also competed well, running 13:22 for 96th place. On the girls' side, eighth grader Katie Schulze ran with Hailey Obregon for most of the race before pulling away in the final half mile to finish in 86th place with a time of 14:55. Obregon, a seventh grader, ran 15:19 for 105th. Thank you for all the support and donations making this trip possible.
