Jen Hukari. opened the meeting with a prayer at 3:15 p.m. and then followed with introductions of board members and people attending the meeting.

**Review**

Treasurer's Report: Jen Highley is still working on getting the accounts transferred and balanced due to the playground getting finished.

Box Top Coordinator: Lisa Potts has volunteered – she has done it with other schools.

Scholastic Book Fair: Dates confirmed for December 4-8, 2017.

Volunteer Forms: Approximately 30 were collected, will create e-mail lists to send out volunteer requests

Sam's Club: Reminder that the card is in the CPTL box, and is tax exempt. General Card for people to use for school purchases – was used to purchase the BBQ last spring.

**New Business:**

Fall Fundraiser: All attendees were in agreement to do the Yankee Candle Fundraiser. It raised about \$7000 with no promotion last year, and we should be able to do more this year, with promoting it. Sending it out 9/21 in the pechees, to be returned October 6<sup>th</sup>, so that the orders can be placed by October 18<sup>th</sup>. This way the items will be in by Thanksgiving. We can also online sell for a period of time after we receive the paper orders, and receive credit for those as well. There will be no Oktoberfest this year, and we will look to other fundraising options in the Spring.

School Directory: Vanessa has volunteered to create a form to send home to get parents information to be included in the directory. There will be no charge for the electronic version (Google doc or similar), and price is TBD if we print for families. There will be an "opt-out" option, for those who do not want their information given to other families. This directory will allow us to attempt to reach people for volunteers, etc. Jen Hukari is also working with Mr. Soderstrom on possibly creating an online version of the directory as well, or in place of, the electronic version.

Fig Bars: The Company will donate the bars for us to sell. They are \$12 per box profit for the school. We could talk to Sandy about sending the order form with Hot Lunch order – takes about 3 weeks to process the orders once they are received back. The amount of times we send out the order forms also depends on the amount of volunteers we have to help sort and hand out the orders. We are still waiting on further details from Sheena Bond.

**Upcoming Events**

Next CPTL Meeting: We are meeting October 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. The location is tentatively in Ms. Medel's room. If she's unavailable for the meeting we will find another location to meet. This meeting is going to be publicized and emphasized that we are discussing the Thanksgiving Feast (held on 11/17) and that anyone who wants to provide input should show up. We will try to do evening meetings about once per quarter that way those who can't miss work, etc. can still show up if they choose to.
