### **Transyl-mania** by Flip Kobler and Cindy Marcus

Transylvania High School is where the kids of all the classic monster movie villains go to learn the tricks of the trade. There are vampires, mummies, werewolves, zombies, witches, Frankenstein's daughter, the invisible Man's son, and even the phantom of the Opera's kid, all of them struggling to live up to their parents' legendary examples.
