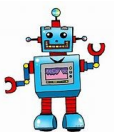

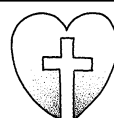

The Tah-Neva League Championships had many of the Bethlehem athletes show off their 8 weeks of training by posting PR's (Personal Records) in their respective events. We had three ladies on our 7th grade girls team. Gracie Waite, Chloe Friend, and Hannah Straub all showed great improvement in hurdles, long jump, and sprints. The 7th grade boys team was composed of Chris Borges, Josh Fox, Evan Habaradas, Dulin Hukari, Michael Miles, Nathan Tack, Max Woelfel from the 5th grade, Mason Dey, Aiden Fredlund, Chunjae Stewart, and Jace Wakamatsu from the 6th grade, and Kenneth Friend, Nathan Highley, Charlie Miles, and Hayden Steyn from the 7th grade to round out that team. Pierce was fantastic in the sprint events and anchored a strong relay team that included two of the seventh-grade members. Aaron was very consistent in improving his 800 and 1600 times at each meet. Last but not least was our 8th grade girls team of Emma Habaradas, Shelby Harmon, Katie Schulze, Sophia Shepard, Rithika Uppu, and Ella Wick. These ladies had an amazing year and came home with a 2nd place finish at the Tah-Neva League Championships Small School Division. Their work and efforts paid off with a fabulous showing, both as individuals and a team. Ella Wick earned medals in two events by placing 3rd overall in the discus and shot put.
