Treasurer Update

2. Allyson Underwood has been appointed as treasurer. Will be fulfilling remainder of the 2-year term. Elections will be held at the end of this school year.
3. Well Fargo account – no report as we are getting current people on the account. Allyson will meet with Kim tomorrow to get current on accounts.

Ongoing

1. Yankee Candle Fundraiser
 - a. Looking at Tuesday Sept 18th for volunteers to count/process orders
