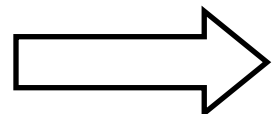

With the 2019 biennial legislative session about to convene, prayers are being sought for lawmakers, particularly with respect to funding and support for the Nevada Opportunity Scholarship. This means-tested program provides financially-challenged families within stated income levels the chance to apply for privately supported scholarships through scholarship tax credits to attend private schools, a good many of which are Christian schools.
