Enrollment for 2019-2020

The link to enroll returning students was sent out last Tuesday. This is all done through FACTS SIS formally known as RenWeb. **To ensure your child's spot at BLS for next year, the enrollment needs to be completed by March 15th**. After March 15th you will be accepted on a "first come, first serve basis" along with new families applying to Bethlehem. **If you have any questions, please contact Sandy in the school office.** A few things to remember as you complete the enrollment:

- **Students entering 7th grade** need a Tdap and Meningitis immunization. The record of these are to be submitted with the enrollment.
- **Students entering Kindergarten** need their birth certificate and current immunizations submitted with the enrollment.
- **Church member discount** sheet must be submitted with the enrollment.
- **If you are paying tuition in full**, you will need to let me know **before** you can complete your enrollment. Payment will be due by June 15th.
- If your child **will not** be attending BLS next year, there is a place for you to mark this so we know.
- If you are applying for FACTS Grants & Aid the deadline to apply, including the follow up documents, is April 1st.

Treasurer Report

1. Bank account issues- resolved
2. CPTL board voted to fund archery program up to \$1500. This is a matching grant but no updates from Mr. Soderstrom yet.
3. Scholastic book fair- feedback. Would like to have volunteers total receipts at the end of each shift to make it less of a chore at the end of the fair. Also, we need to make sure the scanners are working before the opening on the first day. We will request 2 registers going forward.
4. Box tops- will reevaluate the program and its usefulness.
5. CPTL operating budget.
 - a. Operating budget is around \$10,850 but will be reviewed at the end of this year.
 - b. Teacher appreciation dinner went well last year being funded by letter sent to families. Teachers got dinner and potentially a small check.
 - c. Teacher classroom budget to be evaluated. Miss Medel to get feedback from staff.
6. Red Hut dinner- Sierra Lutheran does a fundraiser dinner at Red Hut where tickets are sold and they get a part of the profits for the night. Can we be a part of this by selling tickets also?
7. 8th Grade graduation: will need a small budget for cupcakes, flowers, and balloons.

Agenda items

1. Balance of Yankee Candle Profits / Wish list items: \$1301 remaining, even after \$ for archery.
2. Reader Board- Jenn to look into how much buying additional punctuation will cost.
3. Spring event vs. fundraiser: Board decided we don't need an additional fundraiser at this time.
4. Bike-a-thon
 - a. Money raised goes toward CPTL operating budget for next year including teacher classroom funds and teacher bonus checks.
 - b. Need prizes for motivation
 - i. Allyson suggested a "glow party" of 15-20 minutes for the classes that meet a fundraising goal. Would get a DJ, maybe a high school student, to play music and get a bunch of glow sticks and turn off the lights in the gym. More decisions to be made at the next meeting.

 - iii. Date is set for 4/26 and it is Hawaiian themed.
