MISSION STATEMENT:

To proclaim the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ through witness, mercy, and Christian education Prostate Cancer: A Pastor's Perspective

In December of last year, my doctor noticed an abnormal reading in one of my routine tests. This set in motion a number of procedures over the past several months that culminated in the recent news that I have prostate cancer. This diagnosis came as a shock, but the silver lining is that it was caught very early and has not spread to any other parts of my body.

After careful consideration and consultation with our medical team, we have decided that the best course of action for my long-term health and well-being is to undergo surgery, having a prostatectomy in January. Thankfully, the cancer is slow-growing, so waiting a few months allows me to serve you through the holiday season with virtually no risk to my health. We believe that this surgery is the most appropriate course of action and I expect to make a full recovery. Odds are that I will. Over 99% of men diagnosed with prostate cancer will not die of it, and the odds of living another 15 years or more are very good.

One of the things I have going for me is that I have age on my side. Only 10% of prostate cancer diagnoses are in men under the age of 55. I'm still 10 years away from that, which means it is likely that I will recover faster and more completely than the average prostate cancer patient.

Even more importantly, I have God on my side. King David, the Psalmist says that the Lord "heals all your diseases." (103:3) Jesus shows His power by healing diseases multiple times in the gospels. Cancer, like all sickness and death, was never God's plan for the world He created and called "good." I know that God has a way of turning bad things into blessings, and He can work through even the challenging and painful times of our lives to strengthen our faith. I'm not looking forward to the challenges and pain that will inevitably come my way when I have my surgery and recovery, but I trust that God will use my experiences to help others in the future.

My family and I know that this journey will have moments of uncertainty and fear, but we also believe in God's power to heal and we are thankful for the support of our church family. Your love, prayers, and encouragement have been a source of strength and joy for our family throughout the past seven-plus years, and we are truly grateful to have such a caring congregation by our side.

In the coming months, we may need to reduce our involvement in church activities temporarily as I focus on my recovery and healing. I know our elders and Pastor Abbott are ready to step up and help in my absence. We kindly request your understanding and patience as we navigate this journey together. AUGUST 2023:

- August Offerings of \$21,451 were \$1,949 less than budgeted. August Offerings were also \$2,122 less than last August. Giving Units were 63, a decrease of 10 from July and 2 less than last August.
- Other Operating Expense was \$2,787 over budget, largely due to spending on property maintenance. **Y-T-D:**
- Good performance in July was more than offset by poor performance in August. YTD Net Income of \$283 is only (\$1,452) below budget. Timing and a slow down in late summer may explain the variation these first two months of the year.

Bethlehem Women in Mission Serving the Lord with Gladness

MITE BOX SUNDAY: On the first Sunday of each month, mite offerings are collected. As of August, Bethlehem members have contributed \$608.31 to the District projects. The mites are sent to the California, Nevada, Hawaii LWML District to help fund the mission projects. Bethlehem Lutheran Church sent the mites collected in September to help fund Hope for the Hopeless sponsored by LCMS. The mites collected in October will help fund Connecting Mercy & Church Planting in Latin America sponsored by LCMS Office of International Mission in Latin America and the Caribbean Region.





The Latin America and Caribbean region of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod (LCMS) is blessed to have Concordia the Reformer Seminary in the Dominican Republic. The seminary is serving 47 Seminary students (residential and on-line) in 12 countries throughout the region. The Seminary's Deaconess Formation program serves 140 women in 5 countries. The seminary invests in the practical formation of pastors and deaconesses by supplementing classroom learning with hands-on field work. This grant requests funds to help provide scholarships for students attending the seminary in person and on-line.

Grace Upon Grace, by John W. Kleinig, published by Concordia, is a gem of a book on Lutheran spirituality. Here's an excerpt to pique your interest:

'Christian spirituality is, quite simply, following Jesus. It is the ordinary life of faith in which we receive Baptism, attend the Divine Service, participate in the Holy Supper, read the Scriptures, pray for ourselves and others, resist temptation and work with Jesus in our given location on earth. By our practice of Spirituality, we are not raised to a high plane above the normal, everyday, bodily life, but we receive the Holy Spirit from Christ so that we can live in God's presence each day of our lives as we deal with people and work, sin and abuse, inconvenience and heartbreak, trouble and tragedy.' (P.23)

Liturgy Note: We use a 'common cup', which is another term for the Chalice. If you look closely, you'll see a cover over the Chalice. That cover is called a 'Pall'. And the fine linen that the sacramental vessels are placed is called a 'Corporal'. (From the book 'Exploring Our Lutheran Liturgy, p.20, 21)
