**New Pick-Up Policy** – Below is the new pick-up policy the school board put in place **effective January 6**, **2025**, when we return for Christmas break. This can be found on page 7 of the school handbook which is available on the FACTS Family Portal.

Students are to leave within 15 minutes after school is dismissed unless they are in the extended day care program. Students not picked up by 3:15pm will go to the school office and parents will be called. A fee of \$20.00 for the first 15 minutes, per child, starting at 3:15pm, will be charged. For every 15 minutes following, a fee of \$10 per child will be charged. This will be charged through FACTS incidental billing.
